Dear Collector Car Club:

We are getting ready for the 34th annual Portland Historic Races and would once again like to invite your club to participate in our Collector Car Club display!

Ordering Tickets/Parking Passes:

- Σ Please fill out your form completely....please include your email address if you have one.
- Σ Your fee of \$45 in advance includes a three-day admission ticket for driver and a guest, 1 car corral pass, a dash plaque and the ever-popular parade lap. (\$130.00 value)
- Σ All tickets/car passes for the Collector Car show need to be ordered in advance; **no corral passes will be distributed on-site**. The ticket order deadline is **June 1, 2010**.
- Σ To ease the registration process, **car clubs must register as a collective group**. **Please do not have your members register individually**. Tickets and parking passes will be mailed to you for distribution.
- Σ While we are not limiting the maximum size your corral; we do ask that each corral have a minimum of 4 cars.

Corral Assignments:

The location of the car corrals will be on the infield. We ask that cars be in place by 10:00 am each morning. To avoid traffic delays, we will again use the Turn 8 Gate for the car corrals. In addition, in the morning and the afternoon we will have longer track crossing times to accommodate those coming and going. Also, please assure your club members that they may come and go, as we do have track crossings about every 20 minutes (I will provide a racing schedule in your on-site packet), and assure them that they are not “trapped” on the infield. Finally, since everything is so spread out, please let your club members know that we will have shuttles to transport folks to the Festival Curve Grandstands and to the Bridgestone Bridge rather than “hoofing” it.

Individual corral placement will be at the discretion of Portland Historics. Your corral size will be designed according to the number of cars registered by your club on June 1, so be sure to indicate the total number of cars you expect in your corral.

Parade lap:

On Saturday and Sunday, we present the ever popular lunchtime parade lap. Collector Car participants have the opportunity to take their vehicle out on the racetrack. Each club will be limited to a maximum of 25 cars on the track per day.

Booths: Please contact me if your club is interested in having a booth within your corral to sell club clothing and paraphernalia. Clubs will be charged a booth space of \$190.

Autocross: The autocross will be back this year! While there is not an “official fee” to participate, we do ask that each participant to make a \$5 donation to the Community Transitional School. We ask for this donation for each pass a participant makes. There will be trophies for First, Second and Third place based on the club with the highest amount of donations. The awards will be presented Sunday afternoon. The Autocross will be operational on Saturday and Sunday.

Featured race: Celebrating 100 years of Alfa Romeo

Club Catering: Should your club decide to provide food and beverages for your group, arrangements must be made through the track concessionaire. They can actually cater your group or, if you desire to use another caterer, arrangements must still be made through them (there will be a 30% surcharge).

Club Information: You will notice I have included a line on the application for “Club Website/phone number”: We would like to include a link to your club website from the Historic’s website, as well as list your information in the program - so please provide this information. Also, if your club has a newsletter, please forward me information on advertising; as we would like to place an ad in your newsletter.
